



Super Series & Grand Prize Draw

Terms & Conditions

The following Terms and Conditions apply to participation in the Tennis Excellence (TE) Super Series and the associated Grand Prize Draw. By registering a player for any TE Super Series event, you agree to the conditions outlined below.

1. Eligibility

- Participation is open to junior players enrolled in Tennis Excellence (TE) coaching programs during 2026.
 - Players must participate in at least one TE Super Series event to receive a Player Passport.
 - Grand Prize Draw entries apply only to the registered player and are not transferable.

2. Event Fees

- The entry fee is \$39 per event and includes morning tea.
 - All fees must be paid in full prior to participation in the event.

3. Player Passport & Entry System

Players earn entries into the Grand Prize Draw based on the number of TE Super Series events they attend:

- Two events (two stamps) — One Grand Prize Draw entry
 - Three events (three stamps) — Two Grand Prize Draw entries
 - Four events (four stamps) — Three Grand Prize Draw entries

4. Grand Prize Draw

The Grand Prize Draw will take place at the Term 4 TE Super Series event (Christmas Bonanza).

Prizes include:

1. First Prize: Family Pass to the United Cup Perth – Group Stages (maximum four tickets)
2. Second Prize: One Full Week Pass to a Holiday Clinic of your choice (up to five consecutive days; non-transferable)
3. Third Prize: One 45-minute Private Lesson with a Tennis Excellence coach of your choice
4. Fourth Prize: New Junior Head Tennis Racquet (model subject to availability)

Prize Redemption

Winners will be contacted within five (5) days of the Grand Prize Draw using the contact details provided at registration.

To redeem a prize, winners must email info@tennisexcellence.com.au within fourteen (14) days of notification.

If a prize is not claimed within this timeframe, Tennis Excellence reserves the right to redraw the prize.

5. Event Participation

- Event dates and times are published on TE promotional materials and registration platforms.
- Tennis Excellence may amend event details due to weather or operational requirements.
- A credit or refund will be offered if an event is cancelled or rescheduled by Tennis Excellence.

Withdrawal and Cancellation Policy

- Players must notify Tennis Excellence at least **48 hours prior to the event** if they are unable to attend and provide a reasonable explanation.
- **No refund will be provided for cancellations made within 24 hours of the event.**



Late cancellations create significant difficulty in reorganising match-ups and court bookings and may prevent another player from having the opportunity to participate. We ask all players and families to respect this policy.

6. Photography and Videography

- Photography and videography may occur during TE Super Series events.
 - Images and footage may be used for Tennis Excellence promotional, marketing, and educational purposes across TE platforms.
 - Participation in the event constitutes consent unless Tennis Excellence is notified in writing prior to the event.

7. Liability

- Participation in TE Super Series events is at the player's own risk.
 - Tennis Excellence is not responsible for injury, loss, or damage except where caused by the negligence of Tennis Excellence.
 - Parents or guardians must disclose any relevant medical or behavioural information prior to participation.

8. Privacy

- Personal information collected during registration will be used solely for event administration and prize fulfilment.
 - Information will not be shared with third parties except where required for operational purposes.
 - Personal data is handled in accordance with the Tennis Excellence [Privacy Policy](#).

9. Amendments

- Tennis Excellence reserves the right to update or amend these Terms and Conditions at any time.
